The FIRST THREE Prize-winners in appropriate classes will qualify.
N.C.P.A REGISTERED PONIES ROSETTE will be awarded to the highest placed
N.C.P.A Reg. Pony in classes. Marked R. Red Armband to be worn and Pink
card to be produced. Star Rosette marked with S

1. It is deemed a condition of entry that the Organiser hold no liability for accident, damage or injury to horses, owners, riders, grooms or any person or property whatsoever whilst on the showground.
2. The Organising Committee reserve the right to refuse any entries it may think fit. Also to exclude and withhold any prizes offered, if in opinion of the judge, the exhibits do not possess sufficient merit.
3. No entry will be refunded unless a vet's certificate is produced.
4. The judge's decision is final. Any objection must be accompanied by a deposit of £5.00 within 15 minutes of the end of class.
5. **ALL RIDERS must wear HATS which comply to; PAS 015; VG1; ASTM F1163 04a onwards; SNELL E2001; AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards. accredited while mounted, whether exhibiting or not.**
6. All stallions and colts must be handled by a person over 14 years of age and be adequately bitted and under control.
7. An exhibitor may not knowingly exhibit a pony bred, sold, leased, produced, broken or trained by the judge, and/or his/her immediate family or employer. A rider may not ride in a class judged by someone for whom he/she has ridden for in the show ring in the same year.
8. Lead rein ponies to be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle, the lead rein must be attached to the noseband only.
9. Show Canes/Whips are not to exceed 30" (75cm). In lead rein classes plain or leather covered cane **ONLY** may be used.
10. All Mountain and Moorland, Native / Traditional type horse or pony to be shown in natural state.
11. Exhibitors signatures on the entry form signifies acceptance of the above conditions.

- Class 1 Coloured** Native, traditional and cob, Skewbald and Piebald, Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4yrs and over. Riders any age, to be split if sufficient entries. No Lead Rein exhibits.
- Class 2 Coloured** Non Native Skewbald and Piebald, Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4yrs and over. Riders any age, to be split if sufficient entries. To be shown plaited and trimmed. No Lead Rein exhibits.
- Class 3 Cob Type, Traditional or Hogged Cob:** Stallion, Mare or Gelding 4years old and over any age, any colour.
- Class 4 Sports Horse** Stallion, mare or gelding 4 years old and over, any height, Rider any age.
- Class 5 Riding Horse/ Hack / Hunter** Stallion, mare or gelding 4 years old and over, any height, Rider any age.
- Class 6 Retrained Racehorse** Retrained ex racehorse, Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over.
- Special 1 Championship** 1st & 2nd prize winners from class 1 - 6 to compete.
Champion to compete in the Supreme Ridden Championship
- Class 7 Novice Horse** Not to have won a first prize of £5 or more, Stallion, mare or gelding 4 years old and over, 14.2 and over, Rider any age.
- Class 8 Novice Pony** Not to have won a first prize of £5 or more, Stallion, mare or gelding 4 years old and over, up to and not exceeding 14.2hh, Rider any age.
- Class 9 Novice M&M** Stallion, Mare or Gelding. Must be registered with respective breed societys, will be split in to large & small breeds if sufficient entries. 4 Years old and over, not to have won a first prize of £5 or more.
- Special 2 Championship** 1st & 2nd prize winners from class 7 - 9 to compete.
Champion to compete in the Supreme Ridden Championship
- Class 10 Lead Rein M&M** Mare or gelding, 4 years and over. Not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th Birthday before 1st January in the current year. Snaffle Bridles only.
- Class 11 Lead Rein Show Non M&M** Mare or gelding, 4 years and over. Not exceeding 122cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th Birthday before 1st January in the current year. Snaffle Bridles only. To be shown plaited and trimmed.

Class 12 First Ridden M&M Mare or Gelding, 4 years and over. Not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 13 First Ridden Non M&M Mare or Gelding, 4 years and over. Not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown plaited and trimmed.

Special 3 Championship 1st & 2nd prize winners from class 10 - 13 to compete.
Champion to compete in the Supreme Ridden Championship

Class 14 Open Small Breed Welsh Section A & B, Dartmoor, Exmoor & Shetland. Stallion, Mare or Gelding 4 years old and over.

Class 15 Open large breed Welsh Section C & D, Connemara, New forest, Fell, Highland & Dales. Stallion, Mare or Gelding 4years old and over.

Special 4 Championship 1st & 2nd prize winners from class 14 & 15 to compete.
Champion to compete in the Supreme Ridden Championship

Class 16 Hunter Pony Pony of Show Hunter Type, mare or gelding 4 years and over, not exceeding 15hh

Class 17 Show Pony Mare or gelding, 4years old Ponies not exceeding 14.2hh.

Class 18 Intermediate Hunter/riding type Mare or gelding, 4years old. Exceeding 146cm, but not exceeding 158cm. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 19 Part bred Stallion, mare or gelding 4 years old and over, any height, Rider any age.

Special 5 Championship 1st & 2nd prize winners from class 16 - 19 to compete.
Champion to compete in the Supreme Ridden Championship

Class 20 NCPA Registered Any breed or height, 4 years old and over. Stallion, mare or gelding. **WINNER ELIGIBLE FOR SUPREME.**

Class 21 Walk & Trot Walk and trot only, to be entered in the nature it is intended for, novice riders only.

Class 22 Amateur Rider An Amateur Rider is a rider who for showing purposes HAS NOT engaged in the training programme for Rider/horses/ponies/livery/buying/selling or dealing of horses/ponies as a means of deriving a source of income since 1st August 2015. It is expected that exhibitors will enter into the true spirit of this competition.

Class 23 Veteran Horse/Pony 15 years old and over, stallion, mare or gelding, any height, Rider any age.

Special 6 Championship 1st & 2nd prize winners from class 21 - 23 to compete.
Champion to compete in the Supreme Ridden Championship
