Class 1: NCPA REGISTERED M&M IN HAND

Open to M&M ponies of any age, registered in the main body of their respective stud books. Handler any age, except for stallions or colts where the handler must be 14 years of age or over. Ponies must be registered with the NCPA, registration number to be quoted on entry form. *The winner of this class is eligible for the President's Cup Supreme In hand.*

Class 2: HOME PRODUCED M&M IN HAND SMALL BREEDS, Stallions, mares and geldings, any age

Class 3: HOME PRODUCED M&M IN HAND LARGE BREEDS, Stallions, mares and geldings, any age

Classes 2 & 3 are qualifiers for the NPS/SARACEN HORSE FEEDS M&M HOME PRODUCED IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP. These classes are open to pure bred registered M&M ponies which are either stabled at home or in a DIY yard and which since 1st January in the current year have not been shown by a producer or stabled in a producer's yard other than on a DIY basis or at stud. To be owned/kept, produced, ridden/handled by a person who does not derive their main income from working with horses/ponies. No professional producers are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the horse/pony. Please see NPS 2019 Rule Book Sec A 3.6.. Please enter this class in the spirit it is intended. Competitors who contravene the above will be disqualified.

Class 4: DARTMOOR, EXMOOR & SHETLAND yearling, 2 and 3 year old, colt, filly or gelding.

Class 5: DARTMOOR, EXMOOR & SHETLAND 4 years old and over, stallion, mare gelding

Class 6: WELSH A & B yearling, 2 and 3 year old, colt, filly or gelding.

Class 7: WELSH A & B 4 years old or over, stallion, mare or gelding.

Class 8: WELSH C & D yearling, 2 and 3 year old, colt, filly or gelding.

Class 9: WELSH C & D 4 years old or over, stallion, mare or gelding.

Class 10: HIGHLAND, FELL, DALES, CONNEMARA & NEW FOREST yearling, 2 and 3 year old, colt, filly or gelding.

Class 11: HIGHLAND, FELL, DALES, CONNEMARA & NEW FOREST 4 years old and over, stallion, mare gelding.

Classes 4 – 11 are qualifiers for the NPS/EQUESTRIAN MARKET PLACE M&M IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP. Open to M&M ponies registered in the main body of their respective stud books. Handler any age, except for stallions or colts where the handler must be 14 years of age or over. Classes 4 – 11 are also qualifiers for the Equifest/Spillers In-Hand M&M Championship.

Championship (1) First and Second prizewinners in classes 2 – 11 to compete. *Champion and Reserve eligible for the President's Cup Supreme In hand.*

NPS/Kilmannan Stud M&M In Hand Silver Medal Rosette Championship

A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by the National Pony Society for the best registered pony owned by an NPS Qualifying or Life member in the M&M In Hand section, classes 2 - 11. The Sponsor's Rosette is also awarded to the pony receiving

the qualification. Membership cards must be presented in the ring to receive the medal and/or the qualification.

A pony is not eligible to compete if, before 1st January in the current year, it has done any of the following:

- i. Won an open affiliated mixed M&M Ridden class
- ii. Qualified for Horse of the Year Show, Olympia or RIHS Open M&M Ridden classes
- iii. Qualified for the M&M Novice or Intermediate Ridden final at the NPS Summer Championship show (N.B.

Ponies can compete as novices in this competition for two consecutive years provided they do not submit an entry to the final in the first year).

- iv. If a pony qualifies for Horse of the Year Show, Olympia or RIHS in its second year it is immediately de-noviced and cannot compete in the Picton Final.

Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit.

Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A and Welsh B, stallions, mares and geldings four years old and over, registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society stud book. Riders any age (except stallions – see NPS rules).

Class 18: OPEN M&M RIDDEN LARGE BREEDS

Highland, Fell, Dales, Connemara, New Forest, Welsh Sections C & D, stallions, mares and geldings four years old and over, registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society stud book. Riders any age (except stallions – see NPS rules).

Rules for Training Stakes

Open to any type of horse or pony aged 4yrs and over. Riders any age except stallions (see NPS rules). Competitors will be asked to jump a course of inviting fences and then proceed directly to perform a short individual show. There will be no conformation phase. Each jumping effort to be awarded a style mark out of 5. A mark out of 10 will be awarded for overall impression. Knockdown or refusal = 5 penalties.

Classes 19a, 20a 26a and 27a are qualifiers for the NPS/TEAM HARVEY WORKING HUNTER PONY TRAINING STAKES NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

Class 19: TRAINING STAKES – 46cm to 53cm

- a) Ponies not exceeding 153cm – NPS Qualifier
- b) Leading rein, ponies not exceeding 133cm – not a qualifier

Class 20: TRAINING STAKES – 53cm to 69cm

- a) Ponies not exceeding 153cm – NPS Qualifier
- b) Horses exceeding 153cm – not a qualifier

Class 21: NCPA REGISTERED WORKING HUNTER PONY – jumps not to exceed 70cm

- III. Qualified for the NPS M&M Novice or Intermediate WHP final at the NPS Summer Championship show

Highland, Fell, Dales, Connemara, New Forest and Welsh Section C not exceeding 138cm, mares and geldings four years old and over, registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society stud book. Riders must not have attained their 18th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 39: JUNIOR M&M RIDDEN LARGE BREEDS

Highland, Fell, Dales, Connemara, New Forest, Welsh Sections C & D exceeding 138cm but not exceeding 148cm (except Dales and Welsh Sec D), mares and geldings four years old and over, registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society stud book. Riders must not have attained their 18th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Championship (9) First and Second prizewinners in classes 37 – 39 to compete. *Champion and Reserve eligible for the Chairman's Cup Supreme Ridden and Championship (4).*

NPS

This show is affiliated to the National Pony Society and the NPS affiliated classes will be run under NPS rules.

NPS Mountain and Moorland Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part bred are not eligible.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 6TH – 8TH August 2019. The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a Qualifying or Life member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

B.S.P.S.

This Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society ("B.S.P.S."), and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in B.S.P.S. classes, whether or not members of the B.S.P.S. are subject to the Rules of the B.S.P.S., including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the B.S.P.S.

This Show is a qualifier for the 2019 BSPS Championships Show. 1st & 2nd prizewinners will qualify in classes 44 and 45, 1st prize winners in classes 31, 44 – 46, 48 and 49 will qualify for the BPS Family 50th Year Golden Anniversary Show Champion of Champions.

B.S.P.S. "CLASSIC SECURITY UK LTD" Challenge

The highest placed pony in the Open Show Pony and Open Show Hunter Pony and Heritage WHP classes, that has not qualified for the 2019 Horse of the Year Show in the appropriate class, will qualify. If the highest placed pony has already qualified for the BPS Challenge, the qualification will be awarded to the next eligible pony.

This show is a qualifier for the NCPA Pony of the Year to be held at Warren Farm EC on 8 September 2019. 1st – 3rd placed inclusive in appropriate classes will qualify. Champions and Reserves will qualify for the 'Golden Ticket' Finals.

CHAPS

This show is affiliated to The Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK). Affiliation No. TBC. Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with

CHAPS (UK) to compete. However in order to Qualify both Owner and Rider/Exhibitor need to be a current showing member and present their valid Qualifier card IN THE RING for signing by the judge. Members to apply in writing to CHAPS (UK) for appropriate qualifier card. The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held on 28th – 31st August 2019. All stallions, 4 years old and over entering these classes must be graded with CHAPS (UK). All stallions must wear Stallion ID Discs in the ring without exception.

Show Rules

It is a condition of entry that all Exhibitors agree to be bound by the rules hereunder.

- The organising committee accept no responsibility whatsoever for any loss, injury or damage to any person or property whilst on the showground, car parks or approaches.
- The organising committee reserves the right to refuse any entry without assigning a reason and will not tolerate bad behaviour of any kind.
- Entry Fees will not be refunded, and it is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure the entry is correct, eligible and that they are available for their classes, unless a veterinary certificate is produced.
- In the event of the show being cancelled, refunds will be made less an administration fee of £3.00 per entry.
- Exhibitors must take into consideration any classes that may clash. If this occurs, they must nominate which class they wish to compete in.
- No nomination or substitute entries will be accepted.
- The Judge's decision is final. Any objections must be made in writing with a deposit of £30.00 CASH. (to be forfeited if the objection is over-ruled) within 30minutes of the class taking place.
- Entries for any affiliated classes will also be bound by the rules and conditions in force at the time of showing, applicable to the association and the class in which they are exhibiting. It is deemed by the organising committee that all competitors are conversant with all such rules, conditions and directives.
- Horses / Ponies which have been bred, leased or produced by the Judge, his/ her immediate family or employer are not eligible for that class.
- The organising committee reserve the right to amalgamate or split classes and/or alter the running order of classes as it deems fit.
- The organising committee reserve the right to substitute other Judges for those announced in the schedule for any that may be unavoidably prevented from attending. All entries are accepted on this understanding and no refund of entry fees can be made where a substitute is necessary.
- Exhibitors must enter the ring wearing the back number allocated for that class.
- A correctly fitted chinstrap MUST be worn by all competitors whilst mounted. Correctly secured British Standard Skull Caps/Riding Hats nos. EN1384, PAS015 or PAS accredited must be worn, unless competing under the rules of a governing society for a particular class.

- Any horse/pony which is not under adequate control of a competent rider/handler or which in any way constitutes a danger will be asked to leave the showground.
- All Stallions/Colts SHOULD be adequately bitted.
- Stallions may not be handled or ridden by a child under the age of 14 years (12 years for M&M small breeds).
- Foals must be a minimum of 3 weeks old on the day of the show.
- The organising committee reserves the right to expel any animal from a ring should it in their opinion be deemed not to be fit or under sufficient control.
- Anyone found mistreating any animal may be asked to leave the showground and reported to the appropriate body.
- Show Canes and Whips must not exceed 75cms (30ins.) in length.
- There is to be no lunging in the collecting rings.
- Mountains and Moorland Ponies must be shown in accordance with the appropriate pertaining Breed Society Rules.
- Exhibitors must provide proof of registration on request.
- Any Perpetual Trophies must be returned to the organising committee on request and at least two months before the following years summer show, either by hand or by registered post. Any lost trophies are to be paid for at their replacement value.
- Any Dogs on the showground/box park MUST be kept on a lead and under control at all times.
- No mucking out of horse-boxes or trailers is to be undertaken anywhere on the site, please take your litter home with you.
- The use of mobile telephones in the judging rings is prohibited.
- No Horses or Ponies are to be left unattended tied to trailers/horse-boxes.
- Any exhibitor not complying with any of the show rules can be disqualified.
- All equine passports MUST accompany all Horses and Ponies whilst being transported.
