DERBYSHIRE FESTIVAL SHOW RULES

Please Note: It is the competitors'/exhibitors' responsibility to enter the correct class and allow for appropriate time clashing of classes. Classes WILL NOT be held.

Please see website for our Social Media Policy.

ANY ABUSIVE LANGUAGE or BEHAVIOUR TOWARDS SHOW OFFICIALS, ANIMALS or FELLOW COMPETITORS WILL RESULT IN EXPULSION FROM THE SHOWGROUND and by entering this Show you agree to abide by this and all of the following:

- 1 This Show is not open to the Public and operates under the NCPA Child and Vulnerable Adult Protection Policy.
- 2 All persons entering the showground must have Personal and Public Liability Insurance. The Committee will not be held responsible for any damage, loss or injury to any animal, person or property whilst on the showground. Under <u>NO</u> circumstances must anyone other than the Judge, Stewards, Competitors and Grooms enter the show rings (Grooms please show respect and dress correctly).
- 3 The Judges' decision is final. Any objections must be made, in writing, within one hour of the class/incident and handed to the Secretary with a deposit of £30.
- 4 The Committee reserve the right to amalgamate, cancel or divide classes as entries warrant.
- 5 The Committee reserve the right to return or refuse any entry made either by post or via the on-line entry system.
- 6 Under NO circumstances will entries be substituted and any refunds will be totally at the discretion of the committee and will be subject to the £10 admin charge.
- 7 In the event of postponement all entries will be carried over to the new date unconditionally.
- 8 In the event of cancellation, refunds MUST be requested in writing (NO emails) and should be sent with a SAE enclosed to the Show Secretary within 28 days of the show date and will be subject to a £10 admin charge.
- 9 Mountain and Moorland ponies will be shown in accordance to the Breed Society rules.
- 10 All ridden Show Pony and Show Hunter Pony classes are held in accordance with the BSPS current rule book unless otherwise stated.
- 11 In-foal mares may be asked to produce a certificate of service.
- 12 Stallions may not be lead by children under the age of 14 years to qualify for PUK Championships.
- 13 All trophies will remain the property of the show and must be signed for. They will be held for the remainder of the year and must be returned to the show upon request; clean and in good condition.
- 14 All Postal entries must provide a suitable SAE with the correct postage for return of numbers.
- 15 In the interest of safety, excessive assistance or interference from outside the ring will not be tolerated.
- 16 The Committee reserve the right to carry out random dope testing.
- 17 Dishonoured cheques will incur a £10 administration fee and may result in entries being refused in the future.
- 18 All riding hats should adhere to the current British Standard.
- 19 All data given by competitors is stored on our on-line system and may be shared with other societies. By completing either a paper entry form or entering via the on-line system competitors, owners, riders and handlers give their consent to this and agree to abide by the Rules and Conditions of this Show.

PRIZE MONEY: Full Prize Money will be awarded in each class providing there are a minimum of 6 entries; if less, then 1st Prize Money ONLY will be awarded.

Horse of the Year Show: 1st £30, 2nd £15, 3rd £10, 4th £5. All other classes (except foal) 1st £20, 2nd £10, 3rd £5. Rosettes 1st-6th except in HOYS classes.

Prize Money MUST be collected on Show Day, otherwise it will be deemed as a donation to the Show.

BRITISH SHOW HORSE ASSOCIATION

Classes 33-40,63-65,90-97 & 177. Held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Competitors & Horses must be registered or have temporary membership with a Day Ticket. Horses registered with the Association must be Owned, Exhibited and Ridden by current BSHA Members. Riders must be 15 years of age or older. Registration numbers must be quoted on entry form.

Horses competing at the Horse of the Year Show and qualifying shows in The Hunter sections of The Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain classes at their Affiliated Shows cannot compete in Hack, Cobs and Riding Horse classes at the same show, on the same day and vice versa. This does not apply to SHB(GB) Ridden Sport Horse classes.

The three highest placed prize winners in all Open Affiliated classes will qualify to compete in the BSHA Classic Supreme classes at the National Championship Show 2020.

The BSHA offer a Novice, Young Rider and Amateur rosette in each Open class and a Champion rosette for each section (with the exception of Open Working Show Horse, Ladies Show Horse & HOYS Hunter classes).

The Association will award Amateur Home Produced rosette in all Affiliated Open Cob classes (Lightweights and Heavyweights only), the Cob rosettes have been kindly sponsored by TSG and Mr L Turley The awards will go down the line; there is no limit on how many of these rosettes can be claimed in a year.

S.H.B.G.B. In the North West - In-hand Points Champion

Hunter Breeding Classes and In-hand Sport Horse classes are included in the S.H.B.(G.B.) in the North West In-hand Points Competition. Points will be awarded to 1st-4th places in each class. An Award will be made to the horse attaining the highest number of points overall. To qualify, horses that are not registered at the time of the Show must be registered or overstamped with SHB(GB) by 30th September 2020.

S.H.B.G.B. In the North West - Ridden Points Champion

The following classes at the show: WORKING HUNTER; RIDDEN HUNTER.

are included in the S.H.B.(G.B.) in the North West Ridden Points Competition. Points will be awarded to 1st-4th places in each class. Horses must be registered with SHB to qualify. Horses can compete in any of the above classes. An award will be made to the horse attaining the highest number of points overall.

QUALIFYING SHOW for PONIES ASSOCIATION (UK) SUMMER CLASSIC

The 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed competitors will qualify for the Gold Medal series at the 2020 Ponies Association (UK) Summer Classic on Sunday 16th August at Addington Equestrian Centre. No membership is required to enter or compete in any Championship final. Qualification cards are no longer given out in the ring, however, results will be verified by the

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Summer Championships 2020. See rule 448

THE B.S.P.S. CLASSIC SERVICES GROUP 2020 - Rule 516 (2020 Handbook)

All Shows that are affiliated to the B.S.P.S. are qualifiers for the "BSPS Classic Services Group 2020".

Animals competing in the following Open classes will qualify: Open LR, First Ridden, Lead Rein Hunter Type, Show Pony, SHP, WHP, Intermediate SH, SRT and WH and Open Heritage LR, First Ridden, Ridden and WHP classes.

THE B.S.P.S. BLUE RIBAND PONY of the YEAR

The 1st & 2nd placed pony will qualify in the following classes: Horse of the Year Show Intermediate SRT & SH and Show Hunter Pony classes. Owners and riders must be BSPS Members and the Pony registered with the BSPS to qualify.

HORSE OF THE YEAR SHOW QUALIFYING CLASSES

This is a Horse of the Year Qualifier, all data given upon entry of this class is provided to Grandstand Media Ltd and stored on the Grandstand Entries System. For full policy details please visit www.granstandentries.com Horse of the Year Show Qualifiers will be run in accordance with the general rules as set out in the Horse of the Year Show rule book, a copy of which can be downloaded from www.hoys.co.uk Qualification will be verified by Horse of the Year Show office. For M&M classes ponies to be registered in, and complying with the showing requirements of, the main body of their respective stud books. Owners and riders may also be a member with their respective breed society.

BSPS BLACK COUNTRY SADDLES RIDER of the YEAR

The Best Rider in each of the following Open classes at all BSPS Affiliated Shows will be awarded a Best Rider Card and qualify for the Final at the Summer Championships Show: Lead Rein, First Ridden, 128, 138 & 148 Show Pony, Lead Rein of Hunter Type, 122, 133, 143 & 153 SHP, 133, 143 & 153 WHP, Intermediate SRT, SH, WH Classes & Heritage (BSPS Best Rider Ruler 521).

NPS MOUNTAIN and MOORLAND QUALIFYING ROUNDS

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part-breds are not eligible.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS, Life or qualifying members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition, at the NPS Summer Championship Show.

The highest placed pony if owned by an NPS Qualifying or Life Member will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third. Owners' membership cards to be shown in the ring.

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship - wear white armbands where indicated.

NPS SHOW PONY and SHOW HUNTER PONY QUALIFYING ROUNDS

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register or Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB, the GSB, the AHSB, the AASB or in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part-breds are not eligible unless entered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register or Appendix International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB. Ponies mustbe plaited. Qualifying rounds are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by Qualifying or Life NPS members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition. Owners' membership cards to be shown in the ring.

The highest placed pony if owned by an NPS Qualifying or Life member in each class will qualify for the Final. Qualification may pass down to 3rd place. Please note that foals are not eligible for these Championships. Ridden ponies must be registered in any of the British Riding Pony studbook sections or the Ridden Register; the GSB; the AHSB; the AASB, or registered in the main body of their respective M&M Stud Book. Part-breds are not eligible unless overstamped into one of the British Riding Pony studbook sections, or the Ridden Register. The owner does NOT have to be an NPS member in order to qualify for the ridden SP/SHP finals but must become a member in order to enter the Final.

NPS SILVER MEDAL ROSETTE CHAMPIONSHIPS

To be judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the Owner of the champion pony is a qualifying or Life Member of the NPS. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the Qualification goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the Owner of that pony is a Member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the Qualification Card can go no lower than first Reserve. Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the Final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show, August 2020. Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Rosette Championships. Owners' membership cards must be shown in the ring to receive the medal and/or qualification.

NPS /KILMANNAN STUD M&M IN-HAND SILVER MEDAL ROSETTES CHAMPIONSHIP

A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by the National Pony Society for the best registered pony owned by an NPS qualifying or Life member in the Mountain & Moorland In-hand section. The Sponsor's Rosette is also awarded to the pony receiving the Qualification Card. To be run under NPS Rules. Conditions as above.

Class 177 WORKING HUNTER. Stallion (competing stallions must have a red, white and blue ribbon displayed in their tail), Mare or Gelding, 4 years old or over exceeding 148cms (14.2hh approx) to be judged under Horse of the Year Show rules, a copy of which can be downloaded from www.hoys.co.uk Any weight which has qualified as a Grade A Show-jumper or Advanced Event horse as at 1st January in the current year is not eligible to compete in Working Hunter classes.

Marks will be awarded in the following way: PHASE I (60 Marks). A: Jumping Points, 40; B: Style while jumping, 20. PHASE II (40 Marks). C: Conformation, 20; D: Ride, 20. In the event of equality the Conformation Mark from Phase II will take precedence, followed by the Ride Mark and then the Style Mark. Fences will not exceed height of 1.14m (3G 9ins). Fences should have a natural appearance and not be easily dislodged; there should be a minimum of 8 fences and a maximum of 12 fences. The course must contain a combination and should contain a water tray. This class will be judged in two parts. Part One (Jumping) will be judged first, without a jump-off. All clear rounds and any other horses the judges may require will go forward to the next part. A rider can ride up to two horses in the jumping phase but then must select only one horse to take forward into the ride and conformation section if so required (no change of rider is allowed).

The highest placed unqualified horse in the first three will qualify to enter Horse of the Year Show. No horse placed lower than third will qualify. Qualification will be verified by Horse of the Year Show Office.

Held under the rules of the BSHA. Horses must be Registered with the Association and all owners, producers and riders must be Association members. Riders must be 15 years of age or older. Registration numbers must be quoted on entry form.

All competitors must wear a skull cap or hat and safety harness according to the current Approved BSI or European Standards during the jumping phase. Skull caps to have a navy blue or black cover.

Phase I - 70 Marks (A - Jumping Points - 50 Marks; B - Style while jumping - 20 Marks)

Phase II - 30 Marks (C - Conformation, Type, Freedom of Action - 20 Marks; D - Manners & Way of Going - 10 Marks).

In the event of equality the TOTAL MARK from Phase 1 will take precedence, followed by the MANNERS mark, and then the CONFORMATION, TYPE and FREEDOM OF ACTION MARK.

This class is a qualifying class for Horse of the Year Show, NEC, Birmingham, 7th-11th October 2020. Qualification will not pass below 5th place. Qualification will be verified by the Horse of the Year Show office.


