It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that they have entered their classes correctly and are available when classes are commencing.

N.C.P.A. STAR ROSETTES will be awarded in classes 20,29, 48, 53, 60, 64, 67, 70, 81, 83 Exhibitors must enter the ring wearing their N.C.P.A. Badge and present their current Membership Card to the Judge.

N.C.P.A. REGISTER ROSETTES will be awarded to the highest placed N.C.P.A. registered pony in classe 22, 37, 52, 61, 62, 63, 65, 66, 71, 82 It is a condition of entry that the pony's NCPA registered number is quoted on the entry form. Pink cards to be produced in the ring Red armband to be worn

NOTTS/LINCS BRANCH MEMBERS must enter the ring wearing a GREEN armband and present their current Membership Card to receive a Members Rosette for the highest placed in each class.Rosettes to be collected from the Secretary's Office on the day

HEALTH & SAFETY The Safety & Security of persons and animals attending this show is of paramount importance to the organisers of this show. Competitors and all those attending the show are reminded of their obligations under Health & Safety legislation to adhere to the safety instructions of stewards and officials at all times and to adhere to written instruction and signs relating to safety, for example; horse walks, and pedestrian areas, for their own safety and the safety of others who may be affected by their acts or omissions to act. All accidents must be reported to the Health & Safety officer, Mark Moncaster, who can be contacted through the Show Secretary's office and the Accident Record must be completed. Neither the NCPA Notts/Lincs Branch Committee, nor any of its Officers, Servants, or Assistants shall be responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage to any person, animal, or property, or vehicle in connection with this Show. We ask that all exhibitors have third party insurance on themselves and their horse/pony before attending or competing at the show.

As part of the on-line entry, we will require a track and trace information form to be completed with the vehicle registration and the names of those attending the show. Should attendees and /or vehicle registrations change we require you to provide us with the new information prior to the show day. On entry to the show you will be asked your name and the steward will check that the information you have given on the entry form is correct. There is no need for you to bring any track and trace form with you to the show. Please make sure information is correct as this may delay entry to the show.

SHOW RULES

The organisers of the show have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the Health & Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the Officials & Stewards.

IT IS THE RULE OF NEWARK SHOWGROUND AND THE N.C.P.A that a correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats Nos AllPAS015, VGI, ASTM F1163 04a onwards, SNELLE2001, AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards **MUST Be worn by competitors, riders and judges at ALL TIMES whilst mounted. FOR BSPS CLASSES SEE RULE 45 IN THE BSPS HANDBOOK.**

It is a condition of entry that Exhibitors agree to be bound by the rules herewith under Any objection must be made in writing with a deposit of £50.00 in cash, (refundable if the objection is upheld), within 30 minutes of the class taking place.

The organising Committee accept no responsibility whatsoever for any loss, injury or damage to any person or their property whilst on the showground, car parks or approaches.

THE N.C.P.A DOES NOT allow anyone to bring their horses or ponies to ride or walk round at the show **WITHOUT** entering a class due to the N.C.P.A Public liability **INSURANCE Ruling.** Anyone found to be breaking this rule will be asked to leave the showground immediately.

Entry fees will not be refunded and it is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that their entry is correct, eligible and available when called for their class. Exhibitors must take into consideration that classes may clash. If this occurs, they must nominate which class they wish to compete in. No classes will be held up for any competitor.

Entries for affiliated classes will also be bound by the Rules and Conditions in force at the time of showing, applicable to that Association and the class in which they are exhibiting. It is deemed by the organising Committee that exhibitors are conversant with any such rules, conditions or directives.

The organising Committee reserve the right to amalgamate or split classes and alter or amend the running order of classes. In the event of a show being cancelled, entry fees, less a £10.00 deduction for administration charges, will be refunded.

The Committee reserves the right to expel any animal from the ring which in their opinion is not deemed to be fit or under sufficient control.

Show canes or whips to be no longer than 75 cms/30 inches.

Horses/ponies which have been bred, sold, leased or produced by the Judge, his/her immediate family or employer are not eligible for that class.

Mountain and Moorland ponies must be:-

- a) Shown in their natural state.
- b) Registered with their respective Pure Breed Society.
- c) Registration number quoted on entry forms.

Stallions and colts must be adequately bitted and under the control of a competent rider/handler
PLEASE NOTE: It is the rule of NPS & Ponies UK that Stallions/Colts may not be led by any juniors who have not attained their 14th birthday before January 1st in the current year. Riders must have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January of the current year when riding small breed Mountain & Moorland stallions and show/show hunter stallions not exceeding 128cms. Riders of large breed Mountain & Moorland stallions and show/show hunter stallion exceeding 128cms must have attained their 14th birthday before 1s January of the current year.

Lead rein ponies will be shown in a snaffle bridle only. Lead reins attached to the noseband.

A Perpetual Trophy won by a competitor must be returned at the appropriate time to the Secretary either by hand or by registered post. Any lost trophies will have to be paid for at their replacement value.

Any person who is found to be abusive, violent, aggressive, towards any official connected to this Show will be asked to leave the showground IMMEDIATELY

Competitors must abide by ALL the Society Rules at all times.

Competitors are reminded that in W.H.P. classes they must enter the ring when requested to do so, failure to comply will lead to disqualification.

Horses/ponies must be attended at all times when tied to the outside of a lorry or trailer.

PLEASE NOTE RULE 53a; Competitors competing in B.S.P.S classes must only use tack or spurs permissible in B.S.P.S. classes on the showground whilst mounted.

ALL WHP Competitors

Body Protectors **MUST** be worn when jumping in any WHP and WH classes including the practice ring at B.S.P.S affiliated shows, including Tiny Tots, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, WSP, LRWSP and Training Stakes. Please see Page 30 Rule 164a.

This Show is a Qualifier for the 2021 N.C.P.A. Pony of the Year Show and the Part Bred Welsh Ridden Championships to be held in conjunction with the Pony of the Year Show at Warren Farm Equestrian Centre, Formby, Lancashire L37 0AN on Sunday 5th September 2021. First, second and third prizewinners in appropriate classes will qualify and highest not qualified in the first six for Part Bred Welsh in appropriate classes. ALL champions and reserve champions at any NCPA Branch Show will receive a GOLDEN TICKET to qualify for the Golden Supreme Championships to be held at the Pony of the Year Show. Entry for the championships is FREE however competitors MUST be members of the NCPA and ENTER AT LEAST one other class at the championships. Prize money at the final is: 1st £500, 2nd £300, 3rd £100, 4th £50, 5th £25 and £25 for each supreme.

This show is a Qualifier for the NCPA Junior Mountain & Moorland Pony of the Year to be held at the 2021 N.C.P.A Pony of the Year Show. The highest placed pony and rider not already qualified in the first five will qualify. Qualification will go not lower than fifth place. Classes will be marked on a 50/50 mark system. The following classes are qualifiers:

NCPA Junior Mountain & Moorland Ridden Small Breeds: Registered Pure Bred Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A & B Mares or Geldings 4yr old or over. Riders not to have attained their 14th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year.

NCPA Junior Mountain & Moorland Ridden Large Breeds: Registered Pure Bred Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C & D Mares or Geldings 4yr old or over. Riders not to have attained their 18th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year.

This show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society (B.S.P.S) and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in B.S.P.S classes, whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the Constitution and Rules of the B.S.P.S, including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS.

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS “Classic Services Group” Challenge Animals must qualify for the Challenge by attending any BSPS affiliated show & competing in the appropriate Class- Lead Rein, First Ridden, Open Show Pony, Lead Rein of Hunter Type, Open Show Hunter Pony, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, Open Working Hunter Pony, and the Open Intermediate SRT, SH, and WH, and the Heritage Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden and WHP classes will qualify. Please see RULE 516 page 78 of the 2021 BSPS Rule book.

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS “BINKS Family” Champion Of Champions. 1st prize winners in the following classes will qualify-Open Lead, Rein First Ridden, Open Show Pony, Open W.H.P. Open S.H.P. Open L.R.H.T .Open Intermediate S.H.,S.R.T.& W.H., Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden & W.H.P. Please see RULE 519 page 79 of the 2021 BSPS Rule Book.

This Show is a qualify for the B.S.P.S. “White Company” Champion of Champions. 1st prize-winners in the Open Cradle & Nursery Stakes will Qualify. Please see RULE 520 page 79 of the 2021 BSPS Rule Book.

This Show is a qualifier for the 2021 B.S.P.S. Championships Show, to be held at Arena UK, Grantham, Lincs. The 1st and 2nd prize winners only in the following classes Lead Rein & First Ridden, open show pony and Nursery Stakes and the 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize winners in the Open Intermediate S.R.T. (including Mixed Height) W.H. and S.H.T. and C.S will qualify. In MIXED HEIGHT CLASSES the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th placed ponies will qualify for the B.S.P.S. Championships Show, provided the animal is registered in accordance with Rules 21 and 26 and ridden by a BSPS member.

This Show is affiliated to the 2021 Equifest Showing Show, taking place at the East of England Showground on the 19th – 21st August 2021. Qualification cards will no longer be sent to the Show Secretary. Instead it is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have a qualification card before entering the show and getting this signed by either the Judge, Steward or Show Secretary at the time of qualification. Qualification cards will be sent out free of charge to exhibitors on request. Equifest qualifier classes also carry a dual qualification with Ponies (UK) Championships. Please see the relevant website for information regarding these qualifiers.

This Show is a Qualifier for the 2021 NPS Area 4 Northern Breeders Championships sponsored by “M P Gloss Products UK LTD” to be held at the NPS Area 4 North of England Show on Monday 30th August 2021. The champion and reserve champion in the Mountain and Moorland Supreme In Hand championship, the Riding Pony Breeding & Hunter Pony Breeding will qualify. Qualifiers do not have to be members of the NPS.

TSR NAF Five Star Showing Finals - This show is a qualifier for the 2021 TSR NAF Five Star Showing Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

TSR NAF Five Star Riders Finals - 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification flyer in the ring.

TSR NAF Five Star In Hand Finals - The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand sheet will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers MUST have their sheet signed in the ring by the judge/steward, cards are available FREE from the TSR website. Full details at <http://www.theshowingregister.co.uk/>

TSR Medal Awards - TSR members can collect qualification cards & signatures and redeem for a TSR Medal see TSR website for details.

This show is affiliated to Equine Sports UK (ESUK) Grassroots Championships taking place at Arena UK, Grantham, Lincolnshire on the 30th July - 1st August 2021. The three highest placed exhibits will qualify in each class” Please go to www.equinesportsuk.co.uk for clarification.

This show is affiliated to the Shetland Pony Stud Book Society.

Classes must be confined to Registered Ponies. Ponies must be named on the entry form and in the catalogue if one is produced. Society rosettes must only be given to ponies registered with the Society or eligible for registration (i.e. foals) Three-year-old fillies with foals at foot may not be shown. All foals must be a minimum of three weeks old on the day of the Show. All entire males aged 2 years and over must display a stallion disc. There must be no colts or entire males in Young Handlers classes. Children under 14 yrs old may not show colts (excluding foals) or entire males in In-hand classes. Children under 12 yrs old on the day of the show may not show entire males in ridden classes. In the interests of safety, hard hats must be worn by all handlers aged 14 yrs or under in In-hand classes. Exhibitors should not kneel but remain standing while in the ring. Hard hats must be worn by all exhibitors, irrespective of age, in ridden classes. In ridden Classes, if a rider falls off at any time whilst in the ring, both pony and rider must leave the ring, rider dismounted, and take no further part.

This show is affiliated to the Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain

Rules as per the 2021 Handbook. Owners & riders have to be current SHB(GB) members in all ridden classes. **RIHS qualifying classes – Classes 1 – 4, 5, 6, & 28** are qualifying classes for the RIHS 2022 and only horses registered on the 2021 register are eligible to enter. The two highest placed horses in the Lightweight, Middleweight, Heavyweight & Small classes will qualify for the RIHS. No horse lower than second will qualify. In the Working Hunter class the three highest placed horses will qualify. No horse lower than third will qualify. Where there is only one amateur ridden hunter class the two highest placed smalls, the two highest placed lightweights, the two highest placed middleweights and the two highest placed heavyweights will qualify. When there are two classes, in the lightweight section, the two highest placed smalls and the two highest placed lightweights will qualify and in the heavyweight section the two highest placed middleweights and the two highest placed heavyweights will qualify.

Open Working Hunter

Open to mares, geldings, stallions (must wear red, white & blue ribbon in tail) 4yrs old & over exceeding 148cms to be judged in accordance with SHB(GB) rules. Grade A show-jumpers & Advanced Event horses not eligible to compete in these classes.

Novice Working Hunter

Rules state not to have won a total of £200 or 5 BE Points or 200 BS Points.

Day Ticket -this entitles competitors to compete at a maximum of 2 shows in the year at £36 per show – it covers owner and rider membership together with horse registration for these 2 shows. If the class is a qualifying class for RIHS, in order for the qualification to be valid, application for full owner/rider membership and horse registration must be received in the SHB (GB) office within 14 days. AMATEUR STATUS:

A person is an amateur for showing purposes, when showing ridden hunters in an amateur class, ***if he or she does not during the current or previous year:***

- 1) Engage in breeding, livery, buying, selling, dealing or hiring horses in a commercial capacity or as a means of deriving a main source of income.
- 2) Accept remuneration whether it be monetary or goods in kind for employment in connection with horses in a racing, showing or livery stable or riding school (instruction at Pony Club and Riding Club excepted)
- 3) Show a horse owned or sponsored by a company or commercial firm or a horse for which his or her immediate family accepts livery or training charges from a person outside the immediate concern.
In addition persons classed as Amateur must not be supported by a company in any way or act as a Brand Ambassador.
- 4) Own/part own an equestrian establishment including but not limited to riding schools, events centre, stud or livery yard in any capacity, or receive any form of remuneration for employment at an equestrian establishment. For the avoidance of doubt for the purpose of this rule, immediate family members of an owner or part owner of an equestrian establishment who work or are howsoever otherwise engaged or involved in any capacity, whether or not for remuneration at the equestrian establishment, will be treated as being an owner or part owner of that equestrian establishment.
- 5) Show a horse which a professional rider has ridden in any ridden hunter or ridden sport horse class during the current year, with the exception of working hunter classes & ladies hunter classes unless the horse has subsequently been re-registered under new ownership.
- 6) Professional show persons must not enter the Amateur Ring whilst the classes are in progress. A professional show person is another term for a professional producer and as such a professional groom who works for a producer can enter the ring to groom.
- 7) A professional rider must not ride or exercise an amateur's horse on the day it is competing in amateur classes
- 8) A competitor is not eligible to compete in Amateur classes on an Exhibit which has been qualified for either R.I.H.S or H.O.Y.S by a Professional during the current season, except in Ladies & Working Hunter Classes.
- 9) Amateur Home Produced – Horses which are either stabled at home or in a D.I.Y yard and which since 1st January 2021 have not been shown by a professional during the current season or stabled in a professional yard at any time in 2021. Must be ridden by an Amateur. This does not exclude the Amateur owner home produced riders having lessons at any time with an instructor, providing the horse remains stabled at home or in a D.I.Y yard

EQUINE FLU

THE PRESIDENT'S CUP SUPREME IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP

Judging to take place on the completion of all sections eligible for the

championship. The champion and reserve champion from championships 12, 13, 14, 15 & 16 and the first and second placed prize winners in classes 60, 61, 66 & 67 to compete

The champion to receive The Prophet Perpetual Trophy, sash and rosette and the reserve champion to receive The Woodside Perpetual Trophy, sash and rosette kindly given by the Presidents of the N.C.P.A David and Emma Wallace.

Both the champion and reserve champion will qualify for the President's Cup Final to be held at **The Pony of the Year Show 2021**

THE CHAIRMAN'S CUP SUPREME RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP

Judging to take place on the completion of all sections eligible for the championship.

The champion & reserve champion from championships 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 16, 17 & mini supreme championship and the first placed ponies in classes 7, 8, 29, 34, 35, 36 & 37 compete.

The champion to receive The Supreme Ridden Perpetual Trophy and rosette and the reserve champion to receive: The Willingbeck Perpetual Trophy and rosette.

Both the champion and reserve champion will qualify for the Chairman's Cup Final to be held at the **Pony of the Year Show 2021**.

THE MINI SUPREME CHAMPIONSHIP

Judging to take place on the completion of all sections eligible for the championship.

The champion and reserve champion from championships 5, 9, 10 & 11 to compete

The champion to receive The Laura Tomlinson Memorial Perpetual Trophy, sash and rosette and the reserve champion to receive Trophy, sash and rosette

IMPORTANT NOTES
