NOTTS/LINCS BRANCH MEMBERS must enter the ring wearing a GREEN armband and present their current Membership Card to receive a Members Rosette for the highest placed in each class. Rosettes to be collected from the Secretary's Office on the day

HEALTH & SAFETY The Safety & Security of persons and animals attending this show is of paramount importance to the organisers of this show. Competitors and all those attending the show are reminded of their obligations under Health & Safety legislation to adhere to the safety instructions of stewards and officials at all times and to adhere to written instruction and signs relating to safety, for example; horse walks, and pedestrian areas, for their own safety and the safety of others who may be affected by their acts or omissions to act. All accidents must be reported to the Health & Safety officer, Mark Moncaster, who can be contacted through the Show Secretary's office and the Accident Record must be completed. Neither the NCPA Notts/Lincs Branch Committee, nor any of its Officers, Servants, or Assistants shall be responsible or accountable for any loss, injury or damage to any person, animal, or property, or vehicle in connection with this Show. We ask that all exhibitors have third party insurance on themselves and their horse/pony before attending or competing at the show.

SHOW RULES

The organisers of the show have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the Health & Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the Officials & Stewards.

IT IS THE RULE OF NEWARK SHOWGROUND AND THE N.C.P.A that a correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats Nos AllPAS015, VGI, ASTM F1163 04a onwards, SNELLE2001, AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards MUST Be worn by competitors, riders and judges at ALL TIMES whilst mounted. FOR BSPS CLASSES SEE RULE 45 IN THE BSPS HANDBOOK.

It is a condition of entry that Exhibitors agree to be bound by the rules herewith under. Any objection must be made in writing with a deposit of £50.00 in cash, (refundable if the objection is upheld), within 30 minutes of the class taking place.

The organising Committee accept no responsibility whatsoever for any loss, injury or damage to any person or their property whilst on the showground, car parks or approaches.

THE N.C.P.A DOES NOT allow anyone to bring their horses or ponies to ride or walk round at the show WITHOUT entering a class due to the N.C.P.A Public liability INSURANCE Ruling. Anyone found to be breaking this rule will be asked to leave the showground immediately.

Entry fees will not be refunded and it is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that their entry is correct, eligible and available when called for their class. Exhibitors must take into consideration that classes may clash. If this occurs, they must nominate which class they wish to compete in. No classes will be held up for any competitor.

Entries for affiliated classes will also be bound by the Rules and Conditions in force at the time of showing, applicable to that Association and the class in which they are exhibiting. It is deemed by the organising Committee that exhibitors are conversant with any such rules, conditions or directives.

The organising Committee reserve the right to amalgamate or split classes and alter or amend the running order of classes. In the event of a show being cancelled, entry fees, less a £10.00 deduction for administration charges, will be refunded.

The Committee reserves the right to expel any animal from the ring which in their opinion is not deemed to be fit or under sufficient control.

Show canes or whips to be no longer than 75 cms/30 inches.

Horses/ponies which have been bred, sold, leased or produced by the Judge, his/her immediate family or employer are not eligible for that class.

Mountain and Moorland ponies must be:-

- a) Shown in their natural state.
- b) Registered with their respective Pure Breed Society.
- c) Registration number quoted on entry forms.

Stallions and colts must be adequately bitted and under the control of a competent rider/handler

PLEASE NOTE: It is the rule of NPS & Ponies UK that Stallions/Colts may not be led by any juniors who have not attained their 14th birthday before January 1st in the current year. Riders must have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January of the current year when riding small breed Mountain & Moorland stallions and show/show hunter stallions not exceeding 128cms. Riders of large breed Mountain & Moorland stallions and show/show hunter stallion exceeding 128cms must have attained their 14th birthday before 1s January of the current year.

Lead rein ponies will be shown in a snaffle bridle only. Lead reins attached to the noseband.

A Perpetual Trophy won by a competitor must be returned at the appropriate time to the Secretary either by hand or by registered post. Any lost trophies will have to be paid for at their replacement value.

Any person who is found to be abusive, violent, aggressive, towards any official connected to this Show will be asked to leave the showground IMMEDIATELY

Competitors must abide by ALL the Society Rules at all times.

Competitors are reminded that in W.H.P. classes they must enter the ring when requested to do so, failure to comply will lead to disqualification.

Horses/ponies must be attended at all times when tied to the outside of a lorry or trailer.

PLEASE NOTE RULE 53a; Competitors competing in B.S.P.S classes must only use tack or spurs permissible in B.S.P.S. classes on the showground whilst mounted.

ALL WHP Competitors

Body Protectors **MUST** be worn when jumping in any WHP and WH classes including the practice ring at B.S.P.S affiliated shows, including Tiny Tots, Cradle and Nursery Stakes, WSP, LRWSP and Training Stakes. Please see Page 30 Rule 164a.

WHP Junior riders **MUST** be accompanied by an adult in the collecting ring when using the practice fence.

This Show is a Qualifier for the 2022 N.C.P.A. Pony of the Year Show and the Part Bred Welsh Ridden Championships to be held in conjunction with the Pony of the Year Show at Warren Farm Equestrian Centre, Formby, Lancashire L37 0AN on Sunday 4th September 2022. First, second and third prizewinners in appropriate classes will qualify and highest not qualified in the first six for Part Bred Welsh in appropriate classes. ALL champions and reserve champions at any NCPA Branch Show will receive a GOLDEN TICKET to qualify for the Golden Supreme Championships to be held at the Pony of the Year Show. Entry for the championships is FREE however competitors MUST be members of the NCPA and ENTER AT LEAST one other class at the championships. Prize money at the final is: 1st £500, 2nd £300, 3rd £100, 4th £50, 5th £25 and £25 for each supreme.

This show is a Qualifier for the NCPA Junior Mountain & Moorland Pony of the Year to be held at the 2022 N.C.P.A Pony of the Year Show. The highest placed pony and rider not already qualified in the first five will qualify. Qualification will go not lower than fifth place. Classes will be marked on a 50/50 mark system. The following classes are qualifiers:

NCPA Junior Mountain & Moorland Ridden Small Breeds: Registered Pure Bred Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A & B Mares or Geldings 4yr old or over. Riders not to have attained their 14th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year.

NCPA Junior Mountain & Moorland Ridden Large Breeds: Registered Pure Bred Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C & D Mares or Geldings 4yr old or over. Riders not to have attained their 18th birthday before the 1st of January in the current year.

This show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society (B.S.P.S) and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in B.S.P.S classes, whether or not members of the BSPS are subject to the Constitution and Rules of the B.S.P.S, including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS.

This show is a qualifier for the BSPS Winter Championship to be held at Arena UK, Grantham, Lincs 30th April - 2nd May 2022. Competitors placed 1st - 3rd and 1st - 4th in relevant classes will qualify for the BSPS Winter Championships.

Competitors who are competing and have never been a member of the B.S.P.S will have 7 days to become members of the society and register their ponies which will enable them to compete at the winter championships at Arena UK, Grantham, Lincs 30th April - 2nd May 2022.

This Show is affiliated to the 2022 Equifest Showing Show, taking place at the East of England Showground on the 18th - 20th August 2022. Qualification cards will no longer be sent to the Show Secretary. Instead it is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have a qualification card before entering the show and getting this signed by either the Judge, Steward or Show Secretary at the time of qualification. Qualification cards will be sent out free of charge to exhibitors on request.

The champion and reserve champion in the Mountain and Moorland Supreme In Hand championship, the Riding Pony Breeding & Hunter Pony Breeding will qualify. Qualifiers do not have to be members of the NPS.

This show is a qualifier for the TSR NAF Five Star Showing Finals. All In Hand & Ridden classes are qualifiers. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals! The 4 highest placed handlers/riders will qualify in each class. Competitors MUST have their qualification record sheet signed by judge/steward/secretary, record sheets are available FREE from the TSR website. Full details at www.theshowingregister.co.uk/

This show is affiliated to Equine Sports UK (ESUK) Grassroots Championships taking place at Arena UK, Grantham, Lincolnshire on the 28th July - 31st July 2022 The three highest placed exhibits will qualify in each class” Please go to www.equinesportsuk.co.uk for clarification.

This show is affiliated to the Shetland Pony Stud Book Society.

Classes must be confined to Registered Ponies. Ponies must be named on the entry form and in the catalogue if one is produced. Society rosettes must only be given to ponies registered with the Society or eligible for registration (i.e. foals) Three-year-old fillies with foals at foot may not be shown. All foals must be a minimum of three weeks old on the day of the Show. All entire males aged 2 years and over must display a stallion disc. There must be no colts or entire males in Young Handlers classes. Children under 14 yrs old may not show colts (excluding foals) or entire males in In-hand classes. Children under 12 yrs old on the day of the show may not show entire males in ridden classes. In the interests of safety, hard hats must be worn by all handlers aged 14 yrs or under in In-hand classes. Exhibitors should not kneel but remain standing while in the ring. Hard hats must be worn by all exhibitors, irrespective of age, in ridden classes. In ridden Classes, if a rider falls off at any time whilst in the ring, both pony and rider must leave the ring, rider dismounted, and take no further part.

This show is affiliated to the British Show Horse Association (BSHA)
BSHA Rising Star Classes

The two highest placed not already qualified combinations in each section will receive a BSHA qualification rosette and qualification to the Rising Star Finals at the BSHA National Championships in September 2022. The judges will not ride the exhibits in the qualifiers but will ride at the finals.

ALL Rising Star classes will be open to NON-MEMBERS and members who have never qualified for the RIHS or HOYS before (not including SFAS or RIHS Amateur classes before 2022).

There will be regional clinic days offering training from BSHA accredited trainers.

RULES

Rules for BSHA Rising Star Classes which must be entered into the spirit in which they are intended:

1. Open to Non-Members and those with no more than three years BSHA Membership. Owners, Riders and Horses, are not required to be Members of the British Show Horse Association in order to compete in the BSHA Rising Star qualifying classes, the Rising Star Finals will require a day ticket.
2. These classes are specifically aimed at those Horses and Riders who are not regularly qualifying for the major Championship Shows and wish to improve.
3. Riders must not have competed at The Royal International Horse Show or The Horse of the Year Show, with the exception of the BSHA RIHS Amateur classes pre-2022 or SEIB Search for a Star.
4. Open to Horses which are stabled at home or in a DIY or non-show yard.
5. Horses to be ridden by an Amateur, this does not exclude receiving lessons from a Professional showing person.
6. No Professional is allowed to ride, to work-in (in any form), compete, or enter the Ring to groom/strip the Horse.

7. Failure to abide by the Rules may result in ineligibility to compete at the BSHA National Championship Show in any class.
 8. The Judge will ride ALL the exhibits in the final.
 9. To register for the Supreme Final at the BSHA National Championships Show on the 10th September you must upload your details on our website using the details on the back of the qualifying rosette.
- (A) Amateur Status – a person is an Amateur for the purpose of classes run under Association Rules if he/she does not, during the current or previous season:
- (i) Engage in breeding, livery, buying, selling, dealing or hiring horses in a commercial capacity, or as means of deriving a main source of income.
 - (ii) Receive remuneration, whether it be monetary or goods in kind, for employment in the connection with horses in racing, showing, livery stable or riding school (instruction at Pony Club and Riding Club excepted). This does not include the suppliers of ancillary services such as farriers and vets.
 - (iii) Own/Part own an equestrian establishment including but not limited to riding schools, events centre, stud or livery yard in any capacity, or receive any form of remuneration for employment at an equestrian establishment. For the avoidance of doubt for the purpose of this rule, immediate family members of an owner or part owner of an equestrian establishment who work or are howsoever otherwise engaged or involved in any capacity, whether or not for remuneration at the equestrian establishment, will be treated as being an owner or part owner of that equestrian establishment.
 - (iv) Show a Horse owned or sponsored by a company or a commercial firm, or act as a Brand Ambassador, in any showing classes, BSHA or otherwise, or a Horse for which his/her immediate family accepts livery or training charges from a person outside the immediate family concerned. A competitor is not eligible to compete in Amateur classes on an Exhibit, which has been ridden by a Professional Rider in any Open classes, BSHA or otherwise, with the exception of Open Working Show classes and Side Saddle classes, during the current year and the following year, up to but not including the Royal International Horse Show. (This Rule does not apply, if the Horse has been Professionally Produced and ONLY ridden by a Professional, during the current season, or if the horse has subsequently been sold and re-registered under new Ownership).
 - (v) If you ride/compete equines on a regular basis, which you do not stable at home, your Amateur status could be reviewed by the Board, i.e., if you ride/compete multiple equines or ride regularly for one or more owners, you could be deemed professional. On the day when an Exhibit is competing in Amateur classes, Professionals, including Professional Grooms, are not allowed to ride, to work-in (in any form), compete, or enter the Ring to groom/strip the Horse.
 - (vi) **Amateur Owner/Rider:** Open to Horses owned and ridden by an Amateur. This ruling will also apply to Amateurs who wish to compete in the Annual Amateur Points Awards. No Professional, including Professional Grooms, are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse.
 - (vii) **Amateur Home Produced:** Open to Horses, which are either stabled at home or in a D. I. Y. yard and which since 1st January in the current year, have not been shown by a Professional during the current season or stabled in a Professional yard at any time in the current year. To be ridden by an Amateur. This does not exclude Amateur Owner Home Produced riders having lessons at any time with an instructor, providing the Horse remains stabled at home. No Professional, including Professional Grooms, are allowed into the ring to groom/strip the Horse.
