Any abusive language or behaviour towards show officials, animals or fellow competitors will result in expulsion from the showground and by entering this Show you agree to abide by all of the following:

- All competitors must comply with the current Greenlands Equine Centre policy regarding Equine influenza which is 12 months - no horse/pony to have received a vaccination in the previous 6 days prior to competition
- All persons entering the showground must have Personal and Public Liability Insurance. The Committee will not be held responsible for any damage, loss or injury to any animal, person or property whilst on the showground.
- Under NO circumstances must anyone other than the Judge, Stewards, Competitors and Grooms enter the show rings.
- In the interests of safety, excessive assistance or interference from outside the ring, will not be tolerated.
- The Judges' decision is final. Any objections must be made in writing, within one hour of the class/incident and handed to the Secretary with a deposit of £50 which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
- The Committee reserve the right to amalgamate, cancel or divide classes as entries warrant.
- The Committee reserve the right to return or refuse any entry made by the on-line entry system.
- Under no circumstances will/can entries be substituted and any refunds will be totally at the discretion of the Committee and will be subject to the £10 admin charge.
